<p>Steps to reproduce:</p>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. Create a Class and an operation under it.2. Double click on the Operation to open its edition box.3. Add a parameter to the operation and try to set its multiplicity to [0..1] &ndash;> Impossible, the mutliplicity is changed to [empty]			
<p>Workaround:</p>
