Hi

When reversing a problematic Java source, an error message is shown at the bottom of the generation report dialog, but the exact line number where the problem occurred is not shown, so it's very hard to investigate what is the problem.

For example, I have this message:

```
unexpected token: public
```

```
fichier: D:\Projets\MyProject\src\commun\util\test\MyClass.java
```

Not sure what is the problem with that particular file, could be a problem with Modelio Java Designer module or in the source itself, but in any case I have no idea where in that class the problem is as it doesn't tell me which line number.
