<p>In the Operation's edition box, it is impossible to set parameter's multiplicity to [0..1].</p>			
<p>Steps to reproduce:</p>			
<ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>1. Create a Class and an operation under it.</li><li>2. Double click on the Operation to open its edition box.</li><li>3. Add a parameter to the operation and try to set its multiplicity to [0..1] &amp;ndash;&gt; Impossible, the mutliplicity is changed to [empty]</li></ol>			
<p>Workaround:</p>			
<p>It works fine using the Parameter's edition box, or the Parameter's Properties tab.</p>
