<p>When assigning a name to a guard condition (F2) in an activity diagram, the text is split across two lines. Instead of one line containing &amp;ldquo;[left]&amp;rdquo;, for example, I would end up with two lines, one with &amp;ldquo;[le&amp;rdquo; and the other with &amp;ldquo;ft]&amp;rdquo;. Resizing the box fixes it.It&amp;rsquo;s also odd in how it decides to split the line. If I have a simple word &amp;ldquo;yes&amp;rdquo;, the first line contains ye, the second the s.But if I have a longer word, the last or last two letters are assigned to the second string.This is a new behavior in 3.7.1 as opposed to 3.6.1 which I just upgraded from. I didn&amp;rsquo;t see another bug report listed so started a new one.3.7.1, Win7x64</p>
